



# Autumn countryside cowl

## MATERIALS

Size 8, 29" circular needles  
MC (main color) 260 yds worsted weight yarn  
CC (contrasting color) 145 yds worsted weight yarn  
*\*Worked in the round. Place stitch marker after very first row.*

CO 207 sts.

## SEED STITCH CUFF (IN CC)

1st row: \*K1, P1 (Repeat from \* to end).  
2nd row: \*P1, K1 (Repeat from \* to end).  
3rd and 4th rows: Repeat first and second rows once more.  
5th row: Knit.  
6th row: Purl.  
7th row: Knit.

## COUNTRYSIDE PATTERN (IN MC)

1st and every odd row: Knit.  
2nd row: Knit.  
4th and 6th rows: P3, \*K3, P3 (Repeat from \* to end).  
8th and 10th rows: Knit.  
12th and 14th rows: K3, \*P3, K3 (Repeat from \* to end).  
16th row: Knit.

## DIVISION (IN CC)

1st row: Knit.  
2nd row: Purl.  
3rd row: Knit.

## FIRST HALF OF COUNTRYSIDE PATTERN (IN MC)

1st and every odd row: Knit.  
2nd row: Knit.  
4th and 6th rows: P3, \*K3, P3 (Repeat from \* to end).  
8th row: Knit.

## DIVISION (IN CC)

## SECOND HALF OF COUNTRYSIDE PATTERN (IN MC)

1st and every odd row: Knit.  
2nd row: Knit.  
4th and 6th rows: K3, \*P3, K3 (Repeat from \* to end).  
8th row: Knit.

## DIVISION (IN CC)

## COUNTRYSIDE PATTERN (IN MC)

## SEED STITCH CUFF (IN CC)

Bind off loosely and weave in ends.
